The Suwon Global Lifelong Learning Center:

Suwon Global Lifelong Learning Center is located in Suwon, close to Suwon Worldcup Stadium & Kwanggyo subway station, Shinbundang Line. It is a nice area to live, with lots of restaurants, shops, parks, etc nearby.

The work hours are from 9am to 6pm. Programs are mainly divided into two: regular and after school.

- Regular: The regular program operates from 9:00am - 15:00pm and is run as a "camp" for kindergarten, elementary and middle school children. Schools come from all over Suwon to attend 1 day program of themed classes, such as cooking, music, physics, geometry and so on.

- After school: From 4pm - 6pm, the center operates like a traditional hagwon Mon - Fri for kindy, elementary school students and adults. Teachers teach 50 minute blocks, class sizes vary.

- Once a month on Saturday, teachers may work for one-day themed class, paid as compensation holiday or overtime.

Teachers are expected to develop class materials such as PPTs for classes(regular, after school, weekend programs) to create fun and interactive ways for students to learn.
